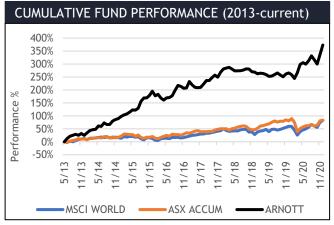
The fund returned positive 8.24% for the month. Net exposure averaged 72% long, while gross averaged 135%.

Our Uranium theme was the largest contributor to fund performance over December. As global economies seek to decarbonise their energy supply chains, Nuclear energy remains the only green sustainable baseload form of power generation. Given this, there is set to be an explosion in new nuclear reactors coming online in the next decade, driving an increased demand for Uranium. With spot Uranium prices trading well below the marginal cost of production, investment in the industry has collapsed and the market is now in a supply deficit. As investors have increased their focus on the winners and losers of global economies seeking to decarbonise their supply chains, we believe there is very good risk / reward payoff in the Uranium space.

In addition to our Uranium theme, Infratil Limited ('IFT') was a substantial contributor to return over the month as they received a non-binding indicative approach from Australian Super at a substantial premium to their current share price. At the start of 2020 we believed demand for data centres globally would resulting in significant asset value accelerate, appreciation. It is within this context we invested in IFT, due to their 48% ownership stake in Canberra Data Centres ('CDC'). We believed the market was completely mispricing IFT given their ownership of CDC. At market prices when we invested, we were paying fair value for their stake in CDC and receiving their 50% stake in Vodafone NZ, Wellington Airport and various renewable energy assets for free. IFT is a classic example of how we seek value within a theme. We also had extremely strong single stock contributions from long position in Independence Group (+37%), BAIDU (+55%), Warner Music Group (+28%). These positions were held across multiple themes and were classic Arnott Capital Asymmetric investment opportunities. Investments made with a significant margin of safety with imbedded value underappreciated by the market.

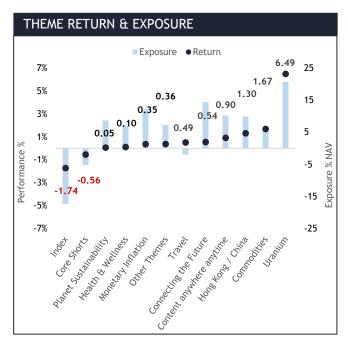

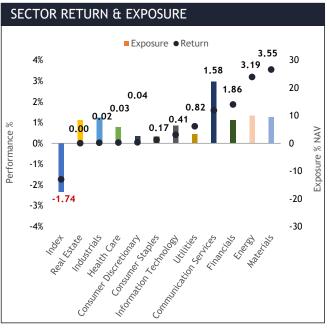

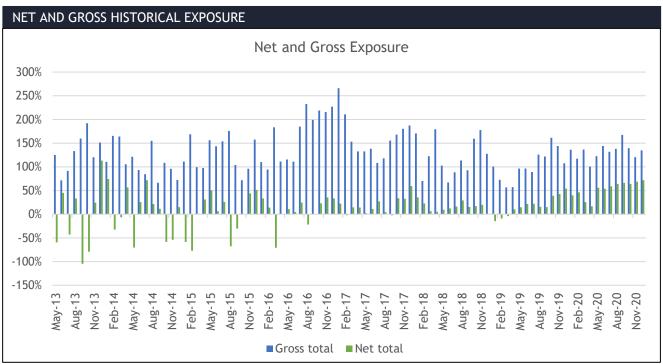

Our Investment Approach:

- 1. Find asymmetric themes
- 2. Invest in the best stocks within those themes
- 3. Focus on macro drivers for risks and opportunities
- 4. To generate an asymmetric return profile

The strategy is global long/short equity with a variable delta bias. The portfolio will typically contain 40 to 70 positions. The fund focuses on identifying underinvested global investment themes through extensive macroeconomic research and then utilises a bottom up fundamental process to identify the highest quality securities within an investment theme to deliver Asymmetric returns for investors.
